16. Nyetimber Classic Cuvée, West Sussex, England		£45.00
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Be one of the very first to try this brand new release vintage from English sparkling wine supremos, Nyetimber! Nyetimber's most recent release offers a younger wine than usual. Still with 4 years bottle ageing, the Classic Cuvée is a fresh and vibrant wine with a lovely amount of fruit. The nose has delicious strawberry notes as well as a soft yeastiness. The palate opens up to juicy tropical flavours including lychees and mandarin.

17. Nyetimber Rosé, Vintage, West Sussex, England		£50.00
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The rosé is a superb example of what we can do best here in England. Chardonnay and Pinot noir varieties made in the traditional Champagne method provide the huge amount of fruit (redcurrant and cherries) present on the nose and palate. This fruitiness is balanced perfectly by the lees-aging brioche notes, as well as the acidity and unabating length.

80% of the Chardonnay come from Pays d'Oc for the roundness and the exotic fruits; And 20% from the Loire valley for the minerality and floral notes of the Chardonnay. Delicate on the palate with lightly honeyed fruit balanced by lemony acidity and a fresh, dry finish. The wine has gentle floral and citrus aromas.

Aromatic, zesty nose with apple, lime and kiwi notes and a hint of minerality. Juicy, weighty fruit with a zippy, citric acid mouth watering feel creating a refreshing, satisfying finish.

- 28. Klein Constantia Estate, Estate Chardonnay, Constantia South Africa** **£60.00**

A medley of fresh citrus and bright fruit notes combined with well-balanced oak integration that contributes an amazing wood spice of cloves and cedar. Its rounded off with a lengthy buttery brioche finish.

- 31. Sancerre, Langlois-Chateau, Loire, France** **£45.00**

Founded in 1885 by Edouard Langlois and his wife, Jeanna Chateau, Langlois-Chateau is considered the premier winery of the Loire Valley. Now owned by Champagne Bollinger, the winery is best known for its elegant Crémant de Loire sparkling wines and for its still wines from the region, including Sancerre.

Made from 100% Tempranillo, this wine spends 12 months in new fine grain American Oak and over 6 months aging in the bottle.
- 47. Paul Mas Domaine Astruc Cabernet Sauvignon, Reserve Languedoc, Roussillon, France** **£29.50**  
Part of an excellent range of single varietals from a Paul Mas owned Languedoc estate, Bucking the local tradition of blended wines. Concentrated, pure Cabernet Sauvignon, New World influenced, but a whiff of southern French hillsides. Good with red meats and tomato based pasta.
- 48. Kelly's Patch 'Last Wish Shiraz', Victoria, Australia** **£29.50**  
Handcrafted and carefully constructed, this succulent Shiraz comes from Central Victoria where Ned once roamed. The nose exhibits fragrant aromas of violets, sweet plums and spice. The palate delivers rich and concentrated blackberry fruit along with pepper and spice combined with beautifully integrated French oak.
- 49. The Pepper Pot Syrah Mouvedre Tannat, Stellenbosch, South Africa** **£29.50**  
Made from grown grapes only in the Stellenbosch region, this wine is created to show the fresh, fruity and spice driven flavours of these Rhone varietals. The colour is youthful and purple/red. The nose is one of crushed black pepper, dark mulberry and mixed berry coulis.
- 50. Rapura Springs, Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand** **£35.00**  
Sweet lifted aromas of cherries and plums, with a hint of currants. Attractive floral notes also appear integrated with savoury mushroom and toasty oak.
- 51. Domaine Les Cres Ricards, Syrah Grenache Appelation, Coteaux du Languedoc, France** **£37.50**  
A deep ruby colour and a complex bouquet of spices (peppercorns and cinnamon), tobacco, mocha and stewed blackcurrants. On the palate it is full-bodied, velvety, toasted and fruity (blackcurrant backed up by black cherry), with a particularly liquorice finish.

Intense crimson-red. A complex and subtle nose of blackcurrant and plum followed by roasted coffee and cinnamon, cherry and morello cherry. A spicy palate with liquorice and fruity characteristics.
- 56. Marqués de Murrieta, Gran Reserva, Rioja, Spain** **£65.00**  
With a deep blackcurrant colour, the nose is fragrant and perfumed; the wine has notes of black fruit, truffle, violets and cigar box. The palate is firm but balanced with mouth-coating tannins and a sweetly seductive finish.

### 58. Chateau de Pez, Saint St Estephe, 2009/10, Bordeaux, France

Bright, dense, with a deep shimmering colour. The wine has a powerful toasty nose with hints of freshly roasted coffee. The palate is strong and intense with persistent aromas of black fruit.

### 59. Marques de Murrieta, Tinto, Reserva, Spain

£70.00

Aged in American Oak Barrels for 2- 3 years and another 2 years in bottle Marques de Murrieta Reserva is the essence of Rioja. The results are a silky smooth wine with subtle well integrated oak flavours and great elegance.

### 60. Domaines Paul Mas, Vignes de Nicole Cabernet Sauvignon-Syrah, VDP, France

Red Brick in colour, with a palate of oriental spices, this multi award winning Tawny Port has spent the majority of its aging time spent in oak which oxygenates the wine to give it a lighter, warmer more feminine style.
